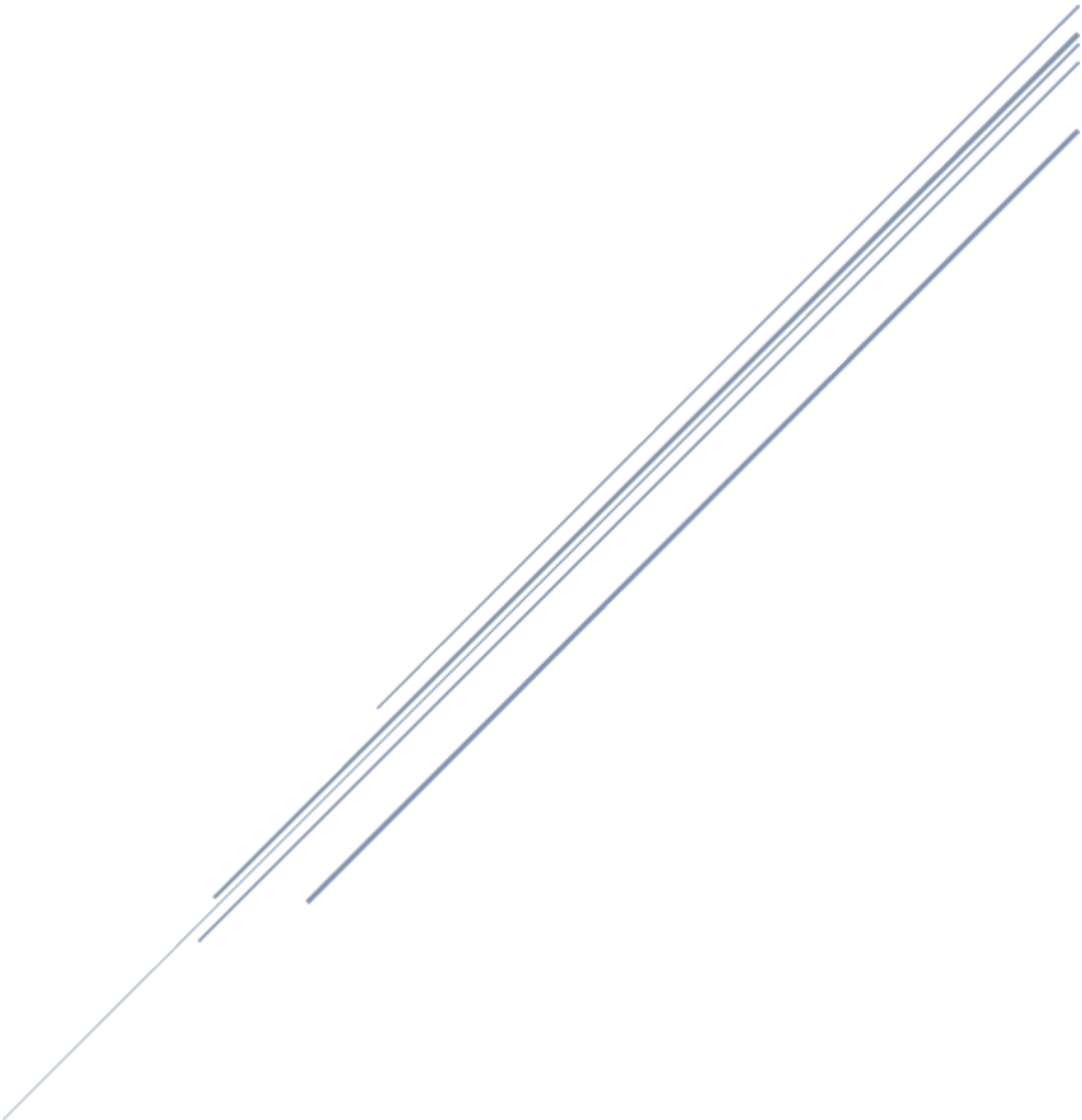


# Mettpay WooCommerce Plugin – Merchant Integration Guide

Payment Gateway



This guide explains how to integrate the Mettpay WooCommerce Plugin with your WooCommerce store.

Please follow the steps below carefully.

## Step 1: Upload the Plugin

- Locate your WordPress installation directory.
- Navigate to: “app/public/wp-content/plugins/”
- Copy the folder named: “mettpay-woocommerce-plugin” into the plugins directory.

## Step 2: Configure Required Parameters in the Plugin Code

- Open the plugin file named: “mettpay-woocommerce-plugin.php”
- Navigate to line 127 (commented as: Pass data here). Provide the required parameters as described below:

### Required Fields

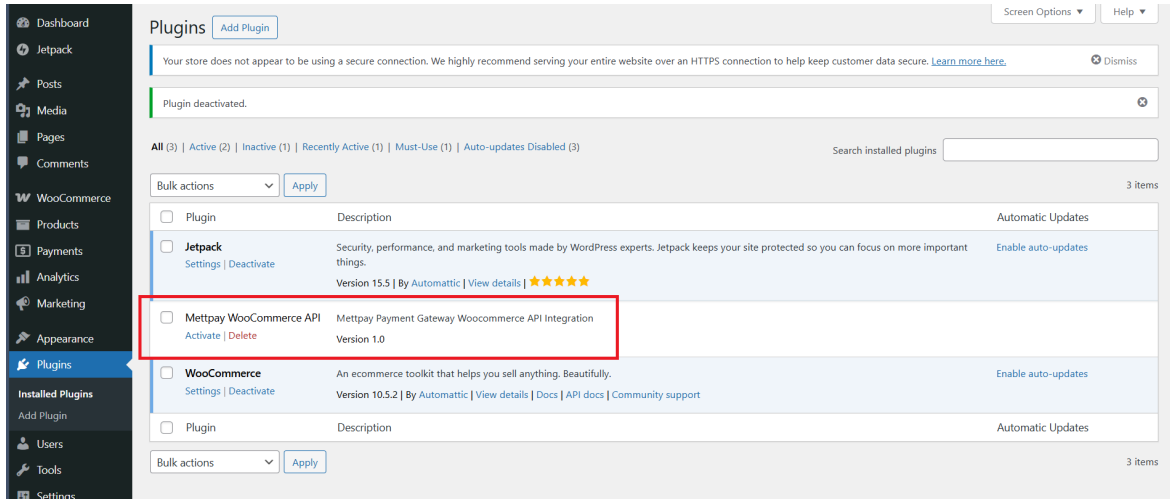
- **Id** - Used to uniquely identify the order.
- **returnUrl** - The URL used for the Cancel button on the checkout page.
- **returnSuccUrl** - The URL of your custom Success Page. This page is shown after a successful payment. It is also used for the back arrow button on the receipt page.
- **returnErrorUrl** - The URL of your custom Error/Failure Page. This page is shown if the payment fails. It is also used for the back arrow button on the receipt page.
- **Customer Fields** - Customer-related details that are primarily displayed on the receipt page.

Please ensure all values are accurate before proceeding.

### Step 3: Activate the Plugin

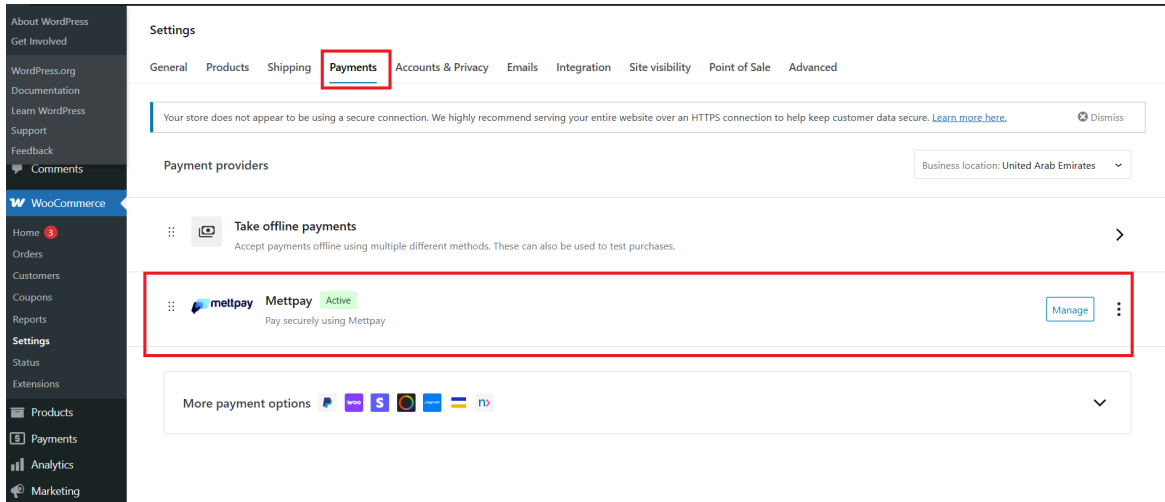
- Log in to your WordPress Admin Dashboard.
- Go to: Plugins → Installed Plugins

- Locate: Mettpay WooCommerce API
- Click Activate.

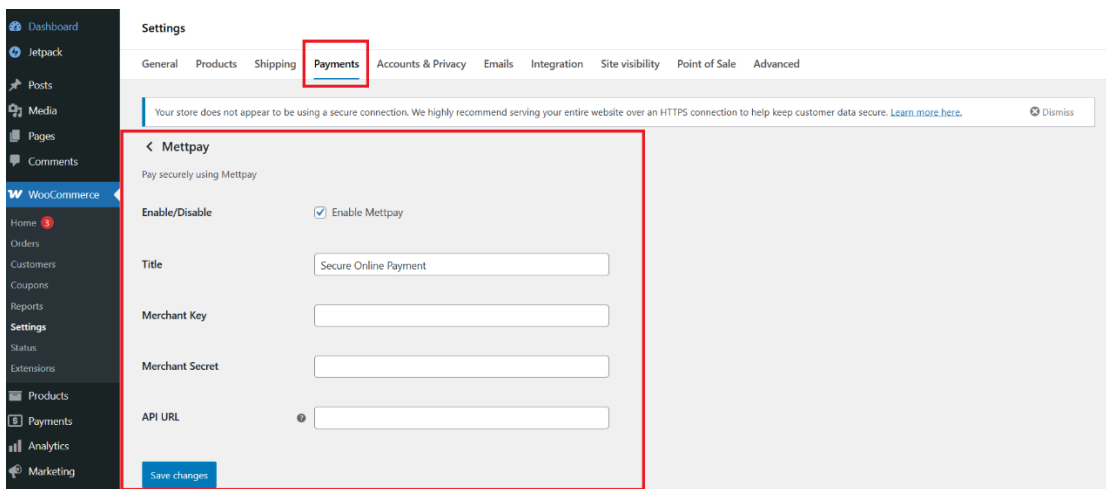


## Step 4: Configure Payment Settings

- Navigate to: WooCommerce → Settings → Payments
- Locate Mettpay and click Manage.



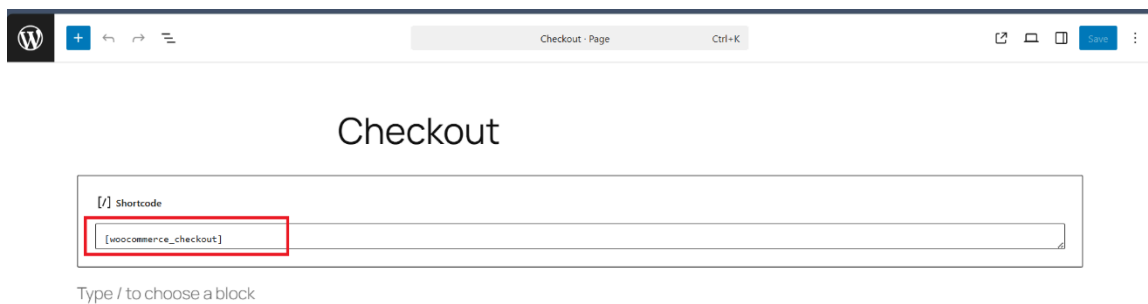
- Enter the following credentials:
  - API Key
  - Secret Key
  - Payment Gateway URL
- Click Save Changes.



## Step 5: Configure the Checkout Page

- Go to: Pages → Checkout
- If the page contains a Checkout Block, remove it.
- Add the following shortcode instead:  

```
[woocommerce_checkout]
```
- Click Save/Update.



### Important Note

After completing the setup, Mettpay will be the only active payment gateway available on your website.
